Cyclists ride through South West for charity

THE picturesque roads of the South West hosted 25 charity cyclists this week as they passed through Dunsborough en route to Augusta on a seven-day round trip from Perth.

Red Sky Riders members had an overnight stop and cool-off in the ocean on Monday before the Dunsborough Country Women's Association supplied sandwiches for the onward journey in Augusta.

Now in its fourth year, the 1000km ride has raised \$1 million for Solaris-

Care Cancer Support Centres, which provide free therapies for cancer patients to complement mainstream treatment.

SolarisCare and Red Sky Ride marketing and events manager Geoff Hutchinson said the funds raised would help plans to open more regional centres, beyond the existing facility in Bunbury, and expand awareness of the organisation's services so more people could have access in their local areas.
