



Red Sky riders keep fit in good cause

THE Red Sky Ride team — 25 fundraising cyclists accompanied by a police escort — pedalled through the centre of Bridgetown last Wednesday afternoon.

They were on their way to a well-earned full day rest after day four of their 1000-kilometre ride over seven days for Western Aust-

ralians with cancer. Their ride started in Perth on February 27, then travelled through Harvey, Dunsborough, Augusta, Bridgetown, Wagin and York, before finishing in Perth on March 6.

This year's event was dedicated to the memory of 35-year-old Simone Maree Timms, a Perth mother who died of leukaemia last year.

Simone passed away on January 12, 2010, after a relatively short fight with the blood cancer leukaemia. She is survived by her husband Ian Timms and their three young children Oliver, Jack and Louis.

Ian said Simone was always positive while being treated and was supported greatly by SolarisCare.
