**T**IRELESS fundraiser Di Watts has organised a jazzy Valentines concert in Fremantle on Sunday, February 15.

Regularly teeing up events to aid the Red Cross, Mrs Watts has extended her benevolent efforts to help raise money for the SolarisCare Foundation.

The resource has centres at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital in

Nedlands and St John of God Hospital in Subiaco, offering therapies such as reflexology and massage to cancer patients.

Mrs Watts bounced back from a brain tumour eight years ago and her husband's subsequent cancer diagnosis introduced the family to the benefits offered by SolarisCare.

"I know how valuable support is when you're helping a family member through chemotherapy and I'm so glad that there's somewhere like SolarisCare," she said.

The Churchlands resident has enlisted the help of six-piece jazz outfit Adam Hall and the Velvet Playboys to perform at the Valentines show at the Navy Club on High Street, which starts at 4pm.

"So many people I know and wonderful musician friends have been affected by cancer, so I think if you're able to get out there and help, you've got to do it," Mr Hall said.
